Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we begin our cemetery blessings at St Paul's Cemetery at 3.00pm. We will meet at the Chapel for a short prayer service and then bless individual graves. We will be visiting the other cemeteries over the next three weeks. This weekend the Archbishop will be celebrating Mass at St Osburg's at 11.30am. This is to commemorate 1000 years of St Osburg and you are welcome to attend. If any of our Altar servers want to serve, they are very welcome and should go to St Osburg's Sacristy for 11.00am. There is a reception in the Parish hall afterwards and the Lord Mayor and the Bishop of Coventry will be among some of the invited guests.

This week we begin our Youth Group programme. I have written to all of our Year 7 pupils as we prepare for the start of another year with the Youth Groups. Please encourage any Year 7 pupils who are now eligible to join to come along this Tuesday 13th September at 6.30pm in the Library. It is a good way for us to keep in contact with our young people who have moved to secondary school. 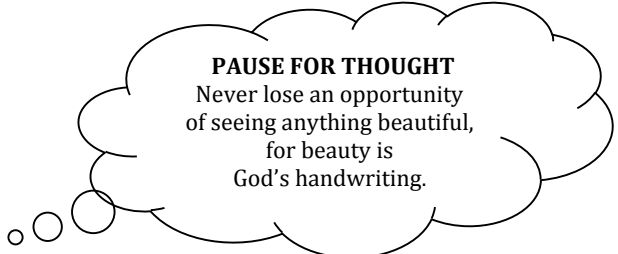
