Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, in union with people around the world, we remember those who gave their lives in warfare. Remembrance Sunday is an important part of our history and an opportunity to show respect to those who pay the ultimate price with the sacrifice of their lives. Coventry has always been a place of peace and reconciliation and our prayers today are for those who have died, for those who mourn their loss and praying for peace throughout the world. At each of our Masses we will have a moments silence and will use poppies and wreaths as part of our Offertory Procession. The children preparing for First Communion this year will also be presented with rosary beads following the theme of "Prayer". This week we will be sending out the letters to all the families who have lost a loved one during this past year. We will be inviting them to a Mass of Remembrance for all of those who have died over the last year on Saturday 26th November at the 6.00pm Mass. During the Mass we will light candles and read out the names of those who have died over the last twelve months.

Over the next few weeks we would like to promote some worthwhile local projects and give people the chance to volunteer and work with other Churches. The Winter Night Shelter will open again in December and St Osburg's will host this on a Wednesday evening throughout the winter. If you would like to volunteer to help with the Night Shelter, there are three shifts, evening, night-time and morning. We are also hoping to join in a "Good Neighbours" Project along with the Church of England, HOPE and Age UK.
