Dear Parishioners,

This week we have preparation meetings for First Holy Communion. The Christ the King parents will meet on Wednesday evening and the St Augustine's parents on Thursday afternoon. We will look at the subject of the Bible as the "Word of God" and next weekend the children will be presented with their bibles. Please continue to remember the children and their families in your prayers. Next week we will begin our preparations for the children making their Confirmation in the summer.

Thanks for the continued support of the Night Shelter. You can continue to help by handing in items that are useful to the homeless, such as socks, toiletries, gloves and scarves. There is a list of suggested items at the back of the church and a box to receive the goods. These will be especially welcomed during this cold spell of weather.

Our "Talks on the Faith" will resume on Wednesday, 8th February at 7.00pm and the topic will be "Baptism".

There is a new white book case on the side aisle of the Church which contains some books and resources which you can use with the children during Mass. Please return the resources to the book case at the end of Mass.

Next month we will be starting to recruit volunteers for the "Good Neighbours" Scheme. It will be a chance to work in Coundon and Radford along with members of other Churches. The scheme will visit people who are often on their own and will just require volunteers to give up an hour every few weeks to visit or to even make a regular phone call. All necessary advice and training will be given, so please consider if this is something you would like to do. Someone from Good Neighbours will come and speak at the Masses next month and we will ask you to sign up then.

We are beginning to finalise details for Lourdes in May half term, 27th May to 3rd June 2017. The list is now back out in the Church porch and I would grateful if you could sign up over the next week or so and confirm your place with a £50 deposit. 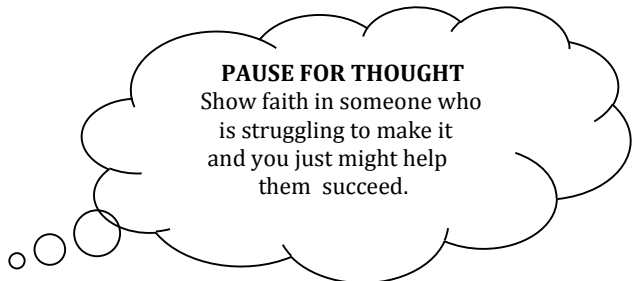
