Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we are focusing on the children who will be confirmed in June. They begin their Confirmation preparation with a Mass of Commitment this weekend at both Christ the King and St Augustine's. We pray for them, for their parents and their Sponsors. If there are any candidates for Confirmation who are not at our schools please let me know as soon as possible so that we can arrange classes for them, so that they too can receive Confirmation in the summer.

The final arrangements are now being made for our Pilgrimage to Lourdes. The Youth Group will be going slightly earlier, on Friday 26th May so that they are ready to start working in the hospital on the Saturday morning. The rest of us will travel on the Sunday 28th May and return on Friday 2nd June. This is the best way of keeping the costs at a sensible level of approximately £570 all in! We do need definite numbers to book the flights by this Wednesday at the very latest. If you want to join after this time, you would have to make your own flight bookings so please let us know after this weekend. We will need a £50 deposit to confirm your booking. Even if you are on the list at the back of the Church, you now need to confirm this as a definite booking with the £50 deposit paid at the Parish Office.

Our "Talks on the Faith" will resume on Wednesday week, 8th February at 7.00pm and the topic will be "Baptism".

In the Deanery this year there will be a number of anniversaries to be celebrated. Fr Bernard Anwyl who is retired at Holy Family will celebrate 60 years as a Priest. Fr Bob Wright will celebrate 40 years, Fr Pat Brennan at Holy Family will celebrate 25 years as will Fr Jonathan Veasey at St John Vianney (25 years) and Fr George Bennett at St Patrick's (25 years). As well as their individual celebrations, we will have a Deanery Mass hosted by Holy Family towards the end of June so that the whole Deanery can celebrate with these five Priests with a total of 175 years of service, details to follow.

There is a new white book case on the side aisle of the Church which contains some books and resources which you can use with the children during Mass. Please return the resources to the book case at the end of Mass.
