Dear Parishioners

This weekend we welcome back Fr Andrew for his presentation. He will be saying the 10.30am Mass at St Augustine's and the 12 noon Mass at Christ the King. We will have refreshments in the Parish Centre after the Mass, so please try and come along. As well as the presentation this weekend, we are making arrangements to attend his Induction next Friday, 3rd November. We are arranging coach transport leaving Christ the King at 6.00pm. Please sign up this weekend at the latest, as we have to book the coaches on Monday morning and we also need catering numbers for Whitnash. You can make your own way there. The Mass begins at 7.00pm at St Joseph's, Murcott Road, Whitnash, CV31 2JJ, for those making their own way there.

This week we have two important Feasts. There is a Holy Day of Obligation on Wednesday for the Feast of All Saints and we have four Masses to choose from. There are not many holy days in the church's year, so please make an effort to come along. We also have the very popular Feast of All Souls on Thursday and there will be a midday Mass and an evening Mass at 7.00pm. This begins our period of prayer for the Holy Souls and we have the Holy Souls envelopes and box at the back of Church and we will end the month with a Mass for all those who have died in the past year. Families will have received letters this week inviting them to come to this Mass on Saturday 25th November at the 6.00pm Mass. We will read out the names of those who have died during the year and light candles in their memory. The list of Holy Souls will be remembered in the Book of Remembrance and we will read a page of this book at each of the Masses in November.

Our Talks on the Faith will take a break for the next couple of weeks and will resume on Wednesday 8th November at 7pm and the title will be "Why did Jesus die?" There will also be handouts to accompany the short DVD covering Confession and Forgiveness. You can follow the course on Youtube if you google "New Alpha Course". Thanks to all those who attended the Walking Club dinner and supported Peter Martin's walk to Santiago. He has raised well over £5,000 for Zoe's Place, Baby Hospice. With the dark nights, the Walking Club will take a break and will resume again in early spring.

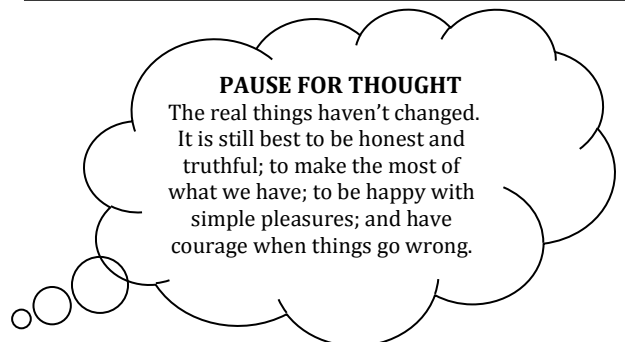
