Dear Parishioners,

This week, things return to normal after the Easter break and most of the groups are up and running. There was a very good response to the talk on "The Gift", which explores prayer and the Holy Spirit. It runs for another five weeks, each Thursday evening at 7.30pm and all are welcome. This is a Deanery initiative and about ninety people attended the first session. Another Deanery initiative is the Pilgrimage to Walsingham. We have booked coaches to depart from St John Fisher and Christ the King at 8.00am on Saturday May 13th. The cost is £15 per person and this includes a levy to Walsingham of £3 per pilgrim.
