Dear Parishioners,

As you know, Fr Andrew has been with us at Christ the King for the last six years. This has been a happy time for him and us and he has grown in experience and confidence as a Priest. He has been a great help and companion to me. He feels it's now time to take the next step and take charge of a Parish of his own. The Archbishop has asked him to work in the Leamington team of parishes and to take charge of St Joseph's in Whitnash. He will work with the parishes of St Peter's, Leamington and Our Lady's, Lillington, as well as being Hospital Chaplain at Warwick Hospital. He will not move until mid-September, but I wanted to share this news with you as it affects other parishes and Priests as well. Fr Andrew has been very popular and has done good work in our Parish and I know we will all miss him, but will also respect his wish to take this next step as a Priest. Please pray for him. He will not be too far away, so will not lose his links with us. We will have him back in October for a Mass of Thanksgiving and of course will be able to attend his Induction as a Parish Priest when this is arranged, probably in the new year. We don't know about arrangements for his replacement just yet, but of course I will let you know when we have news on that. It may be that I will be on my own for a few months. Over the next few weeks we will have Fr Tom Raftery with us and Fr Andrew's friend Fr Ralph Duwell from Florida will also be here for a couple of weeks, so they will be able to give Fr Andrew plenty of advice on his new role before his move! Good news on Fr Andrew's nephew, Patrick. The treatment has significantly reduced his tumor and doctors are very pleased with his progress. Thanks for your prayers.
