Dear Parishioners,

This week, we celebrate the Solemnity of All Saints on Tuesday 1st November. It is a Holy Day of Obligation, so please make every effort to come to Mass. There is a Vigil Mass on Monday evening at 7.00pm at St Augustine's, there is also a morning Mass on Tuesday at St Augustine's, as well as three options at Christ the King. Wednesday is the popular Remembrance of All Souls and again this is a good day to try and come to Mass to remember the faithful departed. We have an extra 7.00pm Mass on that day. We have put out the box for the Holy Souls list and there are now plenty of envelopes at the back of Church if you want to remember your departed family and friends. The Book of Remembrance will be displayed in Church throughout November and we will read from the book at all of the Masses. We will also have a Mass of Remembrance for all of those who have died over the last year on Saturday 26th November at the 6.00pm Mass. The Bereavement Group will be sending out letters inviting relatives of those who have died over the last twelve months. These letters will be sent out next week.

On Tuesday 8th November, the Deanery will have a Mass at St Mary's for all the deceased Clergy who have served in Coventry. The Mass will be at 7.00pm followed by a buffet and a chance to meet the Priests and Deacons of the Deanery. At Mass the names of all the deceased Clergy from Parishes around the City are read out at the Bidding Prayers. Please try to come along. It is also a chance to visit the "Door of Mercy" as the "Year of Mercy" comes to a close.

Over the next few weeks we would like to promote some worthwhile local projects and give people the chance to volunteer and work with other Churches. The Winter Night Shelter will open again in December and St Osburg's will host this on a Wednesday evening throughout the winter. If you would like to volunteer to help with the Night Shelter, there are three shifts, evening, night-time and morning.
