Dear Parishioners

This week, Christ the King School will be celebrating 80 years on the Westhill Road site. The actual date is the 1st February, but we will celebrate the event on Tuesday 30th January at the usual 9.15am Tuesday School Mass. Please do try and come along. We are planning a larger event during the summer term with invited guests and various activities, refreshments and Mass.

Christ the King will be hosting a Day of Evangelisation, preparing for the World Meeting of Families in Dublin and the Eucharistic Congress in Liverpool later this year. The meeting will be in the Parish Library on Saturday 3rd February from 9.30am to 4.00pm. All welcome.

We are hoping to extend our Parish records and will be looking at opportunities to send Parish updates and reflections via email. We will need the balance just before Easter. Most people have paid £50 deposit leaving £450 to complete the payment.

This Friday I had a meeting with the Labour MP, Jim Cunningham. I was able to convey to him and his colleagues our concerns about the Admissions Cap on proposed new Catholic schools. The matter is out for consultation with the new Secretary of State and he has assured us that he and his colleagues will support, should that consultation not be favourable to the provision of Catholic Education. It may be after the consultation we will have to make strong representation again. Thanks for your support and help with this important matter.
