Dear Parishioners

This week we begin our preparation for Lent. We have the "Walk with Me" books and calendars as well as our own Parish programme for Lent. Please try to choose something extra to do for Lent, as well as the traditional practice of giving something up. It is good to make a little sacrifice, but it is also good to try and do something extra for our spiritual life. There are lots of options with extra Masses and Stations of the Cross. We will also have Confessions with visiting Priests and the regular Service of Anointing of the Sick and our Passover Meal on Palm Sunday. Lent starts this Wednesday, which is Ash Wednesday and you will see that there are four Masses in the Parish. Please try and come along and receive the Ashes. Wednesday is also a day of fasting and abstinence. This means that we should eat a little less and abstain from meat. This does not apply to children under 16 and adults over 65 years, although they are free to observe these traditions if they wish.

Next weekend we will have Renewal of Marriage Vows at all of our weekend Masses. Please invite husbands and wives along for this renewal which will be part of the Bidding Prayers at Mass.

We are hoping to expand our Parish records and will be looking at opportunities to send Parish updates and reflections via email. 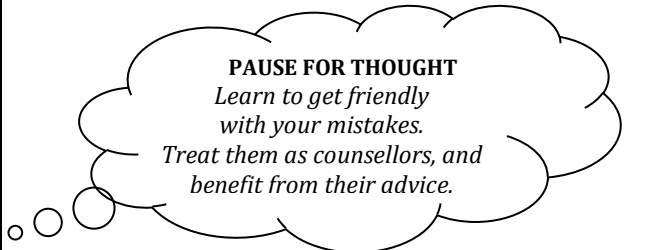
