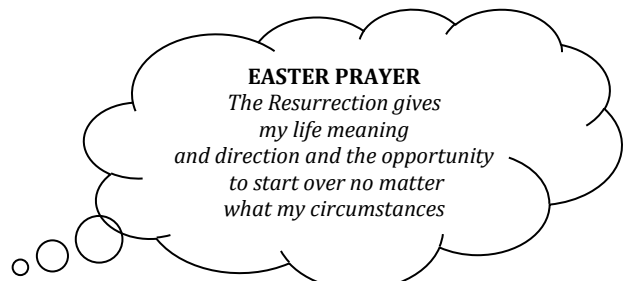
We will have a Parish Finance Meeting on Thursday 12th April, so if you have any suggestions, ideas, please let me know.
