Dear Parishioners

This weekend our children will be preparing for First Confessions. The theme of the Mass will be "Forgiveness" and the children at Christ the King will make their First Confession on Wednesday 7th March at 6.30pm and the children at St Augustine's on Thursday 15th March at 6.30pm. Visiting Priests will be available to allow the parents to come to Confession as well. This Sunday afternoon we have our Altar Servers outing and the coach will leave Christ the King at 2.00pm for bowling in Nuneaton. We will return at 4.30pm approx. The Walking Club will also meet at 3.00pm on the car park, weather permitting. I hope you are managing in the very cold weather and it might be a good idea to offer to help elderly neighbours with shopping and make sure that they are safe at home and have everything they need.

We will be having our Parish Penance Service on Tuesday 27th March at 7.00pm with visiting Priests. There will be a Service of Anointing for the Sick and Housebound on Sunday 18th March at 4.00pm followed by an Easter Tea. Please let people know about this and let us know if lifts are needed. The Passover Meal will be on Palm Sunday, 25th March at 4.00pm and there is a signup sheet this weekend to help us plan for the catering. We also have the 7.00am Mass each Thursday. There is also a Lenten Prayer Group each Tuesday at 2.00pm in the Meeting Room.

Next September we will be opening a new nursery at St Augustine's School. You can find out details about admissions etc. from the school. This will be an excellent new facility for the school and Parish and will be based in the former children's centre on the school site.

We are hoping to expand our Parish records and will be looking at opportunities to send Parish updates and reflections via email.
