She has had a wonderful life of service to God and the Church. Her funeral is this Friday at 9.15am with the Reception of her body on Thursday at 5.00pm. We hope to be joined by Bishop Alan McGuckian (S.J.), Bishop of Raphoe. Please do try and come along.
