Thanks for your support for the funeral of Sister Anne Bagnall. It was good to welcome Bishop McGuckian and to acknowledge Sister Anne's faithful life of service to the Church over so many years and in so many different places. May she rest in peace. Next weekend we begin our First Holy Communions with the 10.00am Mass at St Augustine's. Please note that there will be no 10.00am Mass next Saturday at Christ the King as we will be over at St Augustine's. You are welcome to come to that Mass if you want a morning Mass on Saturday.

I will be away for a few days this week and I am grateful to the Priests from the Deanery who are covering all of the regular Mass times and for Fr Andrew who is covering the funeral for Ray Hennessey on Monday. I will be back on Friday. Over the next month, the children will be making their First Holy Communion at St Augustine's (28th April and 12th May) and at Christ the King (19th May). Please keep the children in your prayers. We will then have our Confirmations in June with Bishop Kenney.
