Dear Parishioners

This week we celebrate the Feast of the Assumption or Our Lady on Wednesday, 15th August. It is a Holy Day of Obligation and I encourage you to come along to Mass. With the schools closed we will have three Masses. The normal Wednesday 9.00am Mass at St Augustine's, 12 Noon and 7.00pm at Christ the King. So, if you want the earlier Mass, come along to St Augustine's and we have still the two options at Christ the King, 12 noon and 7.00pm.

Fr Michael Stack has moved in to the Presbytery and will be helping me on a regular basis. He will stay in the Presbytery until his house in Fullers Close is ready. Many of you will know Fr Michael from his work at Walsgrave / University Hospital and his time at St Osburg's and St Patrick's. He knows Coventry well and I know that he will be a great help to me and a great asset to the Parish. I know that you will make him welcome.

My family wedding in Ireland went well last weekend and I am grateful to Fr Michael and Fr Andrew for covering the weekend Masses.

This review is to be welcomed as a means of ensuring that our systems to protect our children and young people are as effective as possible. This review is being conducted by an independent charity called SCIE (Social Care Institute for Excellence). As part of the review, SCIE would like to speak with any individuals who have had experience with any safeguarding issues within the Archdiocese, and have experience of working with our parish safeguarding representatives and the safeguarding team at the Archdiocese.
