Dear Parishioners,

This week our Newsletter will cover a two-week period. The Mass details for the next fortnight are printed this week. Fiona will be out of the office for a week, so you could leave booking Masses etc. for the next week or so. We are finalising details for the Family Camp on August 31st to September 2nd. There are booking forms at the back of Church, or you can email the Parish Office on admin@ctk-cov.org.uk. This will help us plan numbers for catering.

There is a Community Lunch on Monday 3rd September at 12.30pm in the Parish Centre. It is a two course lunch for £8 and you can sign up at the back of Church.

In September I will be writing to all our Year 7 pupils who will become eligible to join the Youth Group. Please encourage your children to join up in September as we don't want to lose contact with them as they move up to secondary school.

The Walking Club will meet this Sunday and next, at 3.00pm on the car park.

There will be an Igbo Mass this Sunday 19th August at 2.30pm and the Igbo Mass will be every second Sunday of the month throughout the year.

We have a Parish Defibrillator and a number of people are trained to use this. We would like to train some more volunteers and if this is something you are interested in, please ring the Parish Office and we will arrange training in the Autumn. It's a good thing to have available when we have so many people regularly at Church gathered in one place.

We will have the Blessing of Graves over four Sundays in September, starting Sunday 9th September at St Paul's, see overleaf for details.

There is a list at the back of Church for the Harvington Pilgrimage on Sunday 2nd September. Please sign up so we have an idea of numbers. We will need enough people signing up to make it worthwhile.

The Archbishop has asked us to include the following in our newsletters for the next few weeks "Archbishop Bernard Longley has commissioned a review of our current safeguarding/child protection practices in light of the National Catholic Policies and Procedures. This review is to be welcomed as a means of ensuring that our systems to protect our children and young people are as effective as possible. This review is being conducted by an independent charity called SCIE (Social Care Institute for Excellence). As part of the review, SCIE would like to speak with any individuals who have had experience with any safeguarding issues within the Archdiocese, and have experience of working with our parish safeguarding representatives and the safeguarding team at the Archdiocese.
