You may also know that schools are now preparing to join an Academy as a group of schools, hence the need for Directors. The consultation has now begun with parents at our Catholic schools and they will be receiving literature about this. It is important that all of us know and are consulted about the process as well, so there are papers available at the back of the Church and on our Parish website to explain the process to you and give you the opportunity to give your opinion. This is an important time for Catholic education and if we do have some spare time and skill to offer, we should think about giving back as most of us have benefitted from Catholic Education.
