We continue our blessing of the cemeteries this weekend and we will be at Lenton's Lane for 3.00pm. A number of Priests from the Deanery will be helping us. Next Sunday will be the last of the cemetery blessings at London Road, The Walking Club will meet this Sunday at 3.00pm on the car park. It will be a local walk. To mark the end of the walking season, we will have a walk at 1.30pm on Sunday 18th November followed by a lunch in the Library. Please put this date in your diary.

The Youth Group will meet this Tuesday at 6.30pm. It's for the Year 7 pupils and we hope that those that came on the opening night will continue to support the group.

We will be organizing our Talks on the Catholic Faith to start after Christmas, rather than in October. There will be a series of thirteen between Christmas and Easter. This will be for people who want to join the Church at Easter and also for any of us who wish to improve our knowledge of the Faith. The Talks will be a series of DVD, presentations along with talks and handouts. We will also be organising classes for children at non-catholic schools who need to be prepared for their Confession, Communion and for older children, their Confirmation. Classes will start on Tuesday 20th November at 4.45pm in the Library at Christ the King.
