Dear Parishioners,

Thanks to all those who supported the Cemetery Blessings in the month of September. There was a good response and I was grateful to all the Clergy from all around the Deanery who helped at the different cemeteries. It is part of our Catholic tradition to remember the faithful departed and to pray for the Holy Souls. In a couple of weeks, we will have the Holy Souls envelopes available and we will remember our faithful departed in the Book of Remembrance, which we read from at each of the Masses in November. We will also be arranging our annual mass for those who have died during the year. This will be on Saturday $24^{\rm th}$ November at the 6.00pm Mass. We will be writing to all the families inviting them to come to this Mass of Remembrance.

Congratulations to Christ the King school who received a judgement of "Outstanding" from the Diocesan Inspection Team, who Ofsted the Religious Life of the school.

There is a Diocesan Celebration Day in Coventry next Sunday, $14^{\rm th}$ October at Cardinal Wiseman School from 10.00am to 4.00pm. It is a free event, celebrating the World Meeting of Families, the Youth Synod and Adoremus, as well as the Canonisation of Oscar Romero. It should be a good event and a chance to meet with the Archbishop, who will say Mass at 11.00am. All are welcome and there are activities throughout the afternoon until 4.00pm. There is a signup sheet at the back of the Church.

The Walking Club will meet this Sunday at 3.00pm on the car park. They will have a local walk from the car park. Next Sunday, the Walking Club will walk with refugees in mind.
