Dear Parishioners,

By the time you read this Newsletter, I hope to be in China for a holiday with Fr Michael and Fr Dominic. We are all 60 this year so, we always planned to go to China if we all got to 60! I am sure it will be an interesting place to visit, not only for well known landmarks, but also to see how the underground Catholic Church survives in a communist country. Pope Francis is working at the moment to bring the Catholic Church and the Communist State closer together and working towards unity between the underground Catholic Church which is in Communion with Rome and the official Catholic Church, which is still controlled by the Communist Party. During my time away, Fr Michael Stack will be taking care of things and living in the Presbytery. He will be assisted by Fr Michael Dolman, and Fr Andrew Franklin will be helping over two of the weekends. I will be back on 29th October.

This weekend we welcome Fr Michael Dolman, who is the Diocesan Director for Vocations. He will speak at each of the Masses and let you have some literature on Vocations and the Year of Priests. He will also be meeting some of our Youth Group after the 12 Noon Mass. We are grateful for his help. Could we make vocations to the Priesthood and Religious Life a special intention in our prayers this week.

Next week, we will have the Holy Souls envelopes available and we will remember our faithful departed in the Book of Remembrance. We will also be arranging our annual mass for those who have died during the year. This will be on Saturday 24th November at the 6.00pm Mass. We will be writing to all the families inviting them to come to this Mass of Remembrance.

There is a Diocesan Celebration Day in Coventry this Sunday, 14th October at Cardinal Wiseman School from 10.00am to 4.00pm. The Archbishop will say Mass at 11.00am. The Walking Club will meet this Sunday at 3.00pm on the car park. They will be walking with refugees in mind taking part in the CAFOD campaign called "Share the Journey". There is a five mile walk and a one mile option from Coundon Park, opposite Sandpits Lane, at approximately 4.30pm. Also, to mark the end of the season, on Sunday 18th November at 1.30pm we will have a walk followed by lunch in the Library. Please put this date in your diary.
