Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we mark Remembrance Sunday. We will have the traditional minute's silence at each of our Masses and reflect on the sacrifices of so many people as a result of conflict. We will also take the opportunity to pray for peace. This year's Remembrance is particularly poignant as we remember 100 years since the end of the First World War. The 11th November 1918 at 11.00am is the basis for our annual Armistice Remembrance. The children making their First Confession and First Holy Communion will be taking part in the Sunday morning Masses and will be presented with a rosary as we follow the theme of "Prayer and Remembrance". Please keep these children and their families in your prayers as this is an important year for them. During this month of November, we have our traditional Remembrance of the Holy Souls and we have the Holy Souls envelopes and box at the back of Church. We will also be arranging our annual mass for those who have died during the year. This will be on Saturday 24th November at the 6.00pm Mass. We have written this week to all the families who have lost loved ones this year, inviting them to come to this Mass of Remembrance. We will read out the names of those who have died during the year and light candles in their memory. The list of Holy Souls will be remembered in the Book of Remembrance and we will read a page of this book at each of the Masses in November.

To mark the end of the Walking Group for this year, next Sunday 18th November at 1.30pm we will have a walk followed by lunch in the Library.

We will be organizing our Talks on the Catholic Faith to start after Christmas, rather than in October. Classes will start on Tuesday 20th November at 4.45pm in the Library at Christ the King for children at non-catholic schools who need to prepare for Communion and Confirmation.

This weekend we will have a second collection for our St Vincent de Paul Society in the parish. The group do wonderful work for local people who are in need. They do this in a very quiet and anonymous way to maintain the dignity of those who may

need our help. I am sure you will be generous in your support. Next week we have an appeal from the Aid to the Church in Need. They will also have some goods at the back of the Church to support their work.

This Tuesday there is the Annual Mass for the Deceased Clergy of the Coventry Deanery. I will be leading this Mass which is at All Souls Church at 7.00pm on Tuesday. All the Priests and Deacons in Coventry will celebrate the Mass and parishioners are encouraged to attend. We read out the names of the Priests who have served in the various parishes in Coventry and there is a buffet after the Mass. All welcome.

The Archdiocese hearing in the Independent Inquiry into Child Sexual Abuse (IICSA) begins in London on Monday, 12 November, and runs until Friday 16 November. The Archdiocese believes that the work being done by IICSA is of great significance and supports the aim of strengthening and improving safeguarding practices and cultures within the Church. The welfare of children, young people and vulnerable adults is a fundamental priority for the Archdiocese. Fostering a culture which has safeguarding at its very heart remains a key part of our work. Please pray with us for all victims of abuse, and for all those involved in the work of this important Inquiry. With Remembrance Day this Sunday and the Aid to the Church in Need next week, I will speak a little bit about the Church in China in a couple of week's time. This Sunday I will be helping the Bishop of Coventry with the prayers at the War Memorial in the Memorial Park. This is at 11.00am on Sunday morning. It is a very moving ceremony if you have the chance to attend. I will be saying the 6.00pm and 9.00am Masses this weekend and Fr Michael will be saying the 10.30am and 12 Noon to allow me to go to the park. Our thoughts this weekend are for those who have died in warfare, but we also realise there are still conflict and victims around the world and our prayers of remembrance should also be combined with prayers for peace.
