Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we welcome Deacon Tim Anthony who will be speaking on behalf of Aid to the Church in Need at each of our Masses over the weekend. There will also be some products on sale at the back of Church to support the charity. This weekend we have our final walk of the walking season. We will meet on the car park at 1.30pm after the midday Mass and walk for a local walk of about 5 miles. We will be back at Christ the King at 3.30pm for lunch together. All walkers who have joined us this season are very welcome. We are planning a lunch for all our helpers and volunteers in the New Year rather than having it in the rush leading up to Christmas. We will plan something in February when things are a bit quieter.

We continue with our prayers for the Holy Souls in November and next Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> November at the 6.00pm Mass, we have our annual mass for those who have died during the year. We have written this week to all the families who have lost loved ones this year, inviting them to come to this Mass of Remembrance. We will read out the names of those who have died during the year and light candles in their memory. The list of Holy Souls will be remembered in the Book of Remembrance and we will read a page of this book at each of the Masses in November.

We will be organising our Talks on the Catholic Faith to start after Christmas, rather than in October. Classes will start this Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> November at 4.45pm in the Library at Christ the King for children at non-catholic schools who need to prepare for Communion and Confirmation.
