Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we will have our 6.00pm Mass in special memory of those affected by the loss of a baby in pregnancy or in early life or in any other circumstances. We have a shrine around the baptism font so that people can light candles in memory of loved ones, there are also prayer cards available. It is a lovely opportunity to remember loved ones and to honour their memory. We hope it might help bring some comfort and support and help to heal some difficult memories.

This Sunday morning, we have arranged for a coach from Christ the King, leaving at 9.30am for the Mass with the Archbishop in the Cathedral for the Celebration of Marriage. It is especially for those celebrating special anniversaries. We have approximately forty people going. I am sure it will be a very special occasion. Congratulations to all of those celebrating wedding anniversaries. Later in the year we will have the chance to renew marriage vows at all of our masses as we do each year.

Next weekend we have two visiting Priests, Fr Jim Flemming and Fr Tom Ryan from the Columban Fathers. They will be speaking about the Church's missionary work.

Our Talks on the Faith continue at 7.00pm this Thursday and the topic of the talk is the "Baptism". Anyone is welcome to come along to this talk.

Thanks to all those who have expressed an interest in going to Lourdes. We have now filled the 40 places available for the parish and our Youth Group have 25 travelling. We will have a group of 65 from the parish. We can still have the option of booking through the Diocese, this will be slightly more expensive but you can still stay in the same hotel as the parish group.

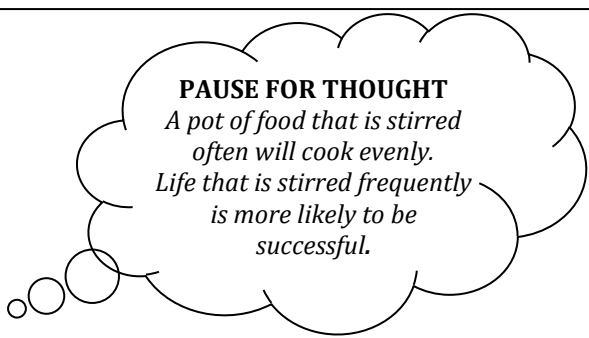
