Thanks to all those who have expressed an interest in going to Lourdes. We have now filled the 40 places available for the parish and our Youth Group have 25 travelling. We will have a group of 65 from the parish. We can still have the option of booking through the Diocese, this will be slightly more expensive, but you can still stay in the same hotel as the parish group. The cost for the main group is £675 and the Diocesan group flying in and out of Birmingham to Lourdes is £800. Booking forms are now available from the office. You will need to pay 50% of the cost by 20th March and the balance is due by 20th May.
