Next weekend we will have the 9.00am and 10.30am masses led by the children on the theme of "Forgiveness". Our Talks on the Faith resume this Thursday at 7.00pm, the theme is "Holy Communion". We also have a Parish Finance Committee at 7.30pm on Wednesday in the Presbytery. Thanks to those who helped cover the Day of prayer last Friday.

Congratulations to Bishop Pargeter who is celebrating sixty years as a Priest this weekend. He has worked for all these years in the Diocese, including trying to teach me Geography! We wish him every blessing. He has visited our parish many times and I am sure you will remember him in your prayers. Thanks to all those who have booked for Lourdes. The trip is now full, although we can take some names for a waiting list in case some people change their minds. The cost for the main group is £675 and the Diocesan group flying in and out of Birmingham to Lourdes is £800. Booking forms are now available from the office. You will need to pay 50% of the cost by 20th March and the balance is due by 20th May.

Fr Michael Stack has written a book about his time as a Hospital Chaplain. It is entitled "Lord when did we see you sick?" It is a series of prayerful meditations based on visits to patients he has made over the years. It is on sale in our parish shop at the back of church and St Augustine's.
