We also have a purple sheet letting you know all of the activities for Lent. Please take one with you and see if there something you can support during the next few weeks. We have regular Stations of the Cross, an extra 7.00am mass on Thursdays and an extra Mass at 7.00pm on Mondays at St Augustine's. There will also be the Anointing for the Sick and Housebound, Confessions with visiting Priests and the Passover Meal.

This weekend we will have the 9.00am and 10.30am masses led by the children on the theme of "Forgiveness". Our Talks on the Faith continue on Thursday at 7.00pm, the theme is "Confirmation".
