This weekend we celebrate Palm Sunday and the start of Holy Week. It is the most important week of the Church's year and I ask you to make every effort to come along and celebrate the Church services. There is a purple sheet at the back of Church giving all the details for this coming week and again you can use this to let family, friends and neighbours know about the services. We also have two new banners outside the Church to encourage people during Holy Week. Please remember the Penance Service on Tuesday evening at 7.00pm. We have a good number of visiting Priests. It is important as part of our Easter duties that we try to come to Confession.

This Sunday we have our Passover Meal at 4.00pm. This is a popular event. The charge for the meal is £7.00 per adult and £3.50 per child.

Our thanks to Caroline Booth and her team who prepared the Easter Tea after our Service of Anointing. Our thanks to all of those who supported this event again this year. There is also the Lenten Reflection Group on Tuesday's at 2.00pm in the meeting room.

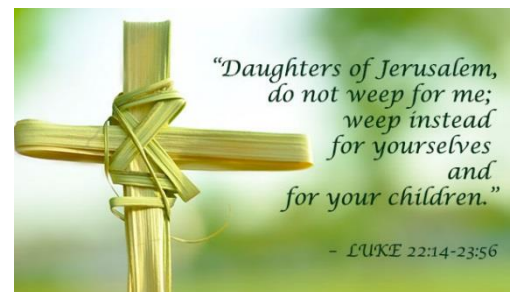
