Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we continue with our First Holy Communions and we congratulate all the children from St Augustine's who are making their Communions over the next few weeks. Congratulations to John Orton who will be received as a Catholic at the 9.00am Mass this Sunday. Next weekend we have the beginning of half term and our parish pilgrimage to Lourdes. Along with our Youth Group we will have just over 60 people travelling. We will remember everyone in prayer, but if you have a particular prayer request you would like us to bring to the Grotto, please drop this request in to the Presbytery this week in an envelope marked "Lourdes Petition". There is no need to put any money in the envelope, just the prayer intention. Next week's newsletter will cover two weeks as we will be away for half term in Lourdes. During half term the office will be closed, so please try to arrange anything this week or the week after half term. Fr Michael Stack will be covering things while I am in Lourdes and will be helped by Fr Tony Norton. Following our Lourdes meeting, we will now lay on a coach at 5.00am from the car park for the main parish group and at 6.00am for the Diocese Group. Thanks for your continued very generous support of the African Cyclone Appeal. A further £300 was handed in last week, so the total is over £3,500 which we will make up to £7,000.
