Dear Parishioners,

This week of half term our Newsletter will cover a two week period. I will be in Lourdes over half term with 60 plus people from the parish. We will remember you all in prayer and will bring along the petitions as requested. During half term the office will be closed, so please leave all enquiries and mass card requests till the week beginning 3rd June when we will be back to normal. Thanks for your co-operation with this. Fr Michael will be living in the Presbytery and will be available for emergencies, but I'd rather he was not troubled with non-urgent matters.

This week we also celebrate the Feast of the Ascension on Thursday. It is a Holy Day of Obligation and we will have a 9.00am mass at St Augustine's, a 12 noon at Christ the King (this is also a funeral mass for Margaret Johnston) and a 7.00pm evening Mass at Christ the King. There is also a 12.10pm midday Mass at St Osburg's which may be more convenient for some. Because we have a 9.00am Thursday Mass at St Augustine's, there will not be a 9.00am Mass on Wednesday as the school is on half term. I am grateful to Fr Tony Norton for helping Fr Michael over the weekend saying mass at St Augustine's.

On your behalf we sent off £7,000 to CAFOD along with £2,500 from your Family Fast collection. We have also sent £1,000 to the Sri Lanka fund for those affected by the Church bombings at Easter. Thanks for your great generosity.

The Walking Club will meet again this Sunday, 26th May and next Sunday 2nd June at 3.00pm on the car park for a local walk. All welcome.

Those wishing to travel to Santiago will need to confirm details with Fiona in the office over the next three weeks please so that we can start booking accommodation. Please let us know by this Monday 20th May at the latest. It is for seven days from Saturday 7th September to Saturday 14th September. The accommodation costs are £550 plus your flight.

The work is being done late evening and during the night so as not to cause any disruption. We are also having the church bells refurbished and these will be back in action week beginning 10th June.
