This week we celebrate the great Feast of Pentecost, the Birth of the Church. It is an important reminder that the Church is a place of welcome for all peoples and at a time when perhaps divisions is emphasised, it is important for the Church to give witness to the dignity and unity of all peoples. At St Augustine's this weekend we have a special 10.30am Mass, led by the Nigerian Igbo Community. We will have hymns and prayers in various languages, representing the diverse nature of the parish community. We will also have a procession of national flags.

This weekend, we celebrate the last of the First Holy Communions at St Augustine's and next weekend we have our first of the Confirmations with Bishop William Kenney on Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> June for the children at Christ the King School and others who have been prepared by the parish catechist. The masses are at 9.00am and 12 noon. The following week, on Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> June we have Confirmations for the St Augustine's children, again with Bishop Kenney at 10.00am.

The Walking Club will meet again this Sunday, 9<sup>th</sup> June for a local walk at 3.00pm on the car park. All welcome.

We now have the arrangements made for Santiago in September. We will collect the first part of the payment of £200 from the beginning of July and the balance of £350 can be paid by 9<sup>th</sup> August. We will have a meeting about the trip in July.

We are looking for a musician who can play the organ or keyboard. This would be a paid position, so if you know of anyone who might be interested please let us know. They don't need to be Catholic. Please phone Fiona at the office.

We are arranging sessions to help find a match for Paddy Igoe who is a young man suffering from a rare form of blood cancer. We have sessions at St Augustine's on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> June and Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> June after the two morning masses at Christ the King. We are looking for volunteers to help on Sunday morning 30<sup>th</sup> June. It's nothing too complicated, just welcoming those who want to give a swab sample. You will be given a short briefing about what you are to do. Please contact Fiona at the office if you are willing to help before or after the 9.00am or the 12 noon mass on that day. We are doing it on that day as so many people come to church and may find it convenient to offer to help.
