This weekend we have the last of our Confirmation ceremonies with Bishop Kenney. He Confirms the children at St Augustine's School. We hope to be able to invite them to join the Parish Youth Group as they move on to secondary school and we will be writing to them in September.

I know that Deacons Pat and Gerry were really pleased with the presentations to mark their twenty years as Deacons. I know that you all really appreciate their wonderful ministry among us. Likewise, thanks from Michael Baldwin who thanks the parish for the presentation and the Guild of St Stephen's Gold Medal. All richly deserved.
