Our thanks to all who helped with the Afternoon Tea last Sunday, helping to raise money for Mission Brazil. The Tea raised just over £1,000. Thanks to all for their generous support. Our young people will be making an appeal for the Brazil Mission on the weekend of 20th / 21st July.

The Walking Club will meet this Sunday for a local walk starting at 3.00pm from the car park. I mentioned the Peace Orchard in Coundon Park in last week's newsletter.
