Dear Parishioners

This weekend we have our Family Camp and we have had another good response and there are 180 people coming over to Packington for the Camp, others will be joining us for the Garden Party on Saturday afternoon. Our thanks to Carmel Keane and her team for organising this which is such a popular event at the end of the summer. This year we are joined by many new families with young children. Fr Michael is back this weekend and will be helping with the weekend masses. Fr Andrew Franklin has kindly agreed to say the 6.00pm Mass on Saturday and I will be back for the 12 noon Mass on Sunday. Fr John Waters is away helping cover the masses in Evesham. He will be back to help during the week and will share the masses next weekend with Fr Michael while I am in Santiago. We have a group of 18 going to walk the last 120km into Santiago.

Over the summer we have had some improvements to the PA System at Christ the King and St Augustine's and have had new church bells fitted at St Augustine's so that we can ring bells for the Angelus, Funerals and Weddings.
