Dear Parishioners

This weekend we are at London Road Cemetery for our Cemetery Blessings. We will meet at the memorial in the newer part of the cemetery and have a short prayer service and then move to the individual family graves for the blessings. Next weekend we will be at St Paul's Cemetery.

The two Youth Groups are now up and running. This week we will have Youth Group from 6.30pm to 8.00pm. The Youth Café have now decided to have their meetings from 7.00pm to 8.30pm. The Youth Café on Tuesday 8th October will be involved in the School Mission at Cardinal Newman.

I am pleased to let you know that we now have permission to install a passenger lift in the Parish Centre. We have to apply for planning permission for this and this has now been granted. I am very grateful to David Parnell for obtaining this permission and undertaking all the work involved. It will be a big financial commitment but will improve our facilities and will allow better use of the large hall upstairs. Perhaps you could think of giving a little more in the collection to help us meet some of these costs. Fr John will be here for the next two weekends before his return to his studies in Rome and Fr Michael should be back to help us once again.

This Tuesday we have a Mass at Bishop Ullathorne to mark the beginning of the Holy Cross Academy. This Multi Academy will take responsibility for Cardinal Newman, Bishop Ullathorne and a number of primary schools feeding into the two secondary schools. These include our two primary schools at St Augustine's and Christ the King. Please pray for the success of the Academy and that the schools can support each other and improve the opportunities offered to our children.
