Dear Parishioners

This weekend we are at St Paul's Cemetery for our Cemetery Blessings. We will meet at the Chapel and have a short prayer service and then move to the individual family graves for the blessings. If people have any other graves at any other cemeteries that they wish to have blessed, please let us know.

There is a School Mission at Cardinal Newman School this week to mark the Canonisation of Blessed John Henry Newman. Carmel Keane and the head boy and head girl of Cardinal Newman will be attending the ceremony in Rome, along with a good number of pilgrims from the Birmingham Diocese. Youth Café this Tuesday 8th October will be held at Cardinal Newman School as part of the Mission. There is Mass at 6.30pm. All welcome. There is also a Mass in the school on Wednesday 9th October at 11.00am with Bishop Kenney to mark the Feast of John Henry Newman. There are Newman prayer cards available at the back of the Church this weekend.

I am pleased to let you know that we now have permission to install a passenger lift in the Parish Centre. We have to apply for planning permission for this and this has now been granted. I am very grateful to David Parnell for obtaining this permission and undertaking all the work involved. It will be a big financial commitment but will improve our facilities and will allow better use of the large hall upstairs. Perhaps you could think of giving a little more in the collection to help us meet some of these costs. Fr John will be leaving us this weekend to return to his Canon Law studies in Rome. We are grateful to him for helping out over the last few weeks and wish him every blessing. He will be back again during the Christmas and the Easter holidays. Fr Michael is back for this weekend.

This month of October, Pope Francis has asked us to think of ways in which we can be a missionary and outward looking Church and to look for opportunities to involve our local community. As a Parish we will look for new ways of engaging with the wider community.

I would like us to improve the way we celebrate the Liturgy. I would like to recruit some new readers, servers and eucharistic ministers. Please let me know if you are interested in helping in any of these ministries. We are also looking to recruit some helpers for the Children's Liturgy group at the 9.00am and 12 Noon Masses. We can arrange training and the opportunity to sit in on the sessions to learn what's involved. I will be asking people over the next few weeks if they are able to help out.
