Dear Parishioners

This weekend Cardinal John Henry Newman will be declared a Saint. There a number of people from Birmingham and Coventry attending the Canonisation Mass and I am sure it will be well covered by the media. It is a great blessing for the Diocese and for all the places connected with Cardinal Newman. There are still plenty of prayer cards at the back of the Church to mark this occasion, please help yourselves. Carmel Keane and the head boy and head girl of Cardinal Newman will be attending the ceremony in Rome, along with a good number of pilgrims from the Birmingham Diocese.

There is an Evening Prayer Celebration at St Chad's Cathedral on Sunday 20th October at 4.00pm to mark the Canonisation. Catholic and Anglican Bishops will be attending and the Choirs of St Chad's Cathedral and St Philips Anglican Cathedral will lead the singing. All welcome.

I am pleased to let you know that we now have permission to install a passenger lift in the Parish Centre. We have had to apply for planning permission for this and this has now been granted. Unfortunately, the chair lift in the Parish Centre is out of order and because of its age we are struggling to get spare parts.
