Dear Parishioners

I hope you had a chance to see some of the Canonisation of Cardinal John Henry Newman or at least some of it covered on the tv and newspapers. Those who travelled from Coventry had a wonderful experience. There are still some prayer cards at the back of the Church, please help yourself.

There is an Evening Prayer Celebration at St Chad's Cathedral this Sunday 20th October at 4.00pm to mark the Canonisation. Catholic and Anglican Bishops will be attending and the Choirs of St Chad's Cathedral and St Philips Anglican Cathedral will lead the singing. All welcome.

This month of October, Pope Francis has asked us to think of ways in which we can be a missionary and outward looking Church and to look for opportunities to involve our local community. As a Parish we will look for new ways of engaging with the wider community. At the masses this weekend, the Sisters of the Holy Rosary, Sister Ruth, Sister Rita and Sister Julie will say a brief word about missionary work at each of the masses.

I would like us to improve the way we celebrate the Liturgy. I would like to recruit some new readers, servers and eucharistic ministers. Please let me know if you are interested in helping in any of these ministries. We are also looking to recruit some helpers for the Children's Liturgy group at the 9.00am and 12 Noon Masses. We can arrange training and the opportunity to sit in on the sessions to learn what's involved. I will be asking people over the next few weeks if they are able to help out. We are also asking for help with teas after mass. It is only once every two months, so could you offer to help. I have visited the schools before half term and we will start practices for Altar Servers on Friday 1st November at 3.45pm in Christ the King Church. Anyone wanting to Serve at St Augustine's, if they can speak with Mrs McManus after Sunday Mass.

The Walking Club will meet on the car park at 3.00pm for a local walk. We have also arranged an end of season get together for next Sunday 27th October at 5.00pm. This will also be a reunion for those who walked to Santiago. We will have a 3.00pm short walk as the clocks go back on that day and will meet at 5.00pm in the Library for a get together.
