Dear Parishioners

This weekend we are remembering all those who have been victims of warfare. Remembrance Sunday is a good time to acknowledge their sacrifice and to pray for peace. At each of our masses over the weekend we will have a short reflection and a time of silence. At the 9.00am and 10.30am masses, the children from Christ the King and St Augustine's will receive Rosary Beads as they begin their preparation for First Confession and First Holy Communion. The theme for their Mass is "Prayer" and Remembrance Sunday is a fitting day on which to remember the importance of Prayer and the importance of giving thanks to God and to those who paid the ultimate price for freedom. This Sunday I will be helping at the Remembrance Day service at the Memorial Park at 11.00am with the Bishop of Coventry.

November is also the time of Remembrance of the Holy Souls and we will read out names from the Book of Remembrance at each of the masses. If you have not already done so, please let us have the names of those you wish to remember. Any offerings made will be given to our St Vincent De Paul Society to help them with their work. You can place the envelopes in the black box at the back of the Church or post through the Presbytery letter box. We will also have a Remembrance Mass for all those who have died over the past year. This will be on Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> November at the 6.00pm Mass. We will be sending out reminder letters to families this week. Please let people know about this.

We had a good meeting with the Catholic Primary School in the city to establish a Chaplaincy Team at each school. Our two parish schools took part and we will be introducing the team of young people at Mass in a couple of week's time.

I would like us to improve the way we celebrate the Liturgy. I would like to recruit some new readers, servers and eucharistic ministers. Please let me know if you are interested in helping in any of these ministries. We are also looking to recruit some helpers for the Children's Liturgy group at the 9.00am and 12 Noon Masses. We can arrange training and the opportunity to sit in on the sessions to learn what's involved. I will be asking people over the next few weeks if they are able to help out. We are also asking for help with teas after mass. It is only once every two months, so could you offer to help.

Thanks to those who have offered to help with Altar Serving. We have had a good response and the training programme started this week. Our thanks to Michael
