Our thanks to all involved in this important work which gives us hope for the future. At the 12 noon Mass we will be joined by pupils from Cardinal Newman School, who will help lead the Liturgy.

Next Sunday we begin the Season of Advent and we will have the "Walk With Me" books, calendars and the parish programme. We also have the traditional Blessing of the Crib in the Precinct next Sunday at 4.00pm by the Library. Please try to support this Deanery event.

We had a good meeting with the Catholic Primary School in the city to establish a Chaplaincy Team at each school.
