Dear Parishioners

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. This is another story telling us of Jesus being revealed as the Son of God. It is also a lovely Feast in which to think of the care and responsibilities parents have for their children and the blessings given in the Sacraments and the Scriptures. These reveal the presence of God in our every day lives. I have asked you to bring your Bibles to Church this week so that we can bless them and make a promise to read them and pray more regularly using the Scriptures. This is all part of the encouragement we have received from Pope Francis, who has asked us to focus a little more on our understanding and use of the Bible. He has asked that this year be the "Year of the Word". In the Coventry Deanery we are planning some events and talks to help us improve our knowledge of the Scriptures and we will let you have details over the next couple of months. Parishes will be hosting talks around the Deanery and will be producing a poster and leaflet with all the details running through to the end of 2020. Pope Francis has asked that our Bibles do not remain as ornaments on a bookshelf but are taken down from the shelf and used for prayer and reading. When was the last time you looked at your Bible at home? I have also produced a leaflet for you all to take home, giving a simple outline of the Bible and how to use the Bible for prayer and reading. Please take one home with you this weekend.

The Talks on the Faith continue this week on the subject of "Baptism and Confirmation". The course is for those thinking about joining the Church at Easter, but also is available to anyone who wants to improve their knowledge of the Faith. The Talks last for 45 minutes.

The classes for children at non-catholic schools continue to meet on Wednesdays at 4.30pm. Please note these are now every two weeks. The
