Dear Parishioners

Thanks for your support of our Lenten Programme so far. This week we begin our Monday evening Mass with Stations of the Cross at St Augustine's at 7.00pm. There was a good attendance at the 7.00am Thursday Mass and both these masses will continue throughout the weeks of Lent. There are still a few "Walk With Me" Books available at the back of the Church if you did not pick up some over last weekend.

The purple sheet outlines the programme for Lent. You will see that we have regular Stations of the Cross, some extra masses, the Service of Anointing for the Sick and Housebound and our Passover Meal. There will also be opportunities for Confession and a Penance Service with visiting Priests. These are all arranged to help you make the most of Lent. We also have a weekly Lenten Prayer Group on Tuesday's at 2.00pm in the Meeting Room.

We will be arranging some Deanery Talks for Lent and Advent 2020, which will be hosted by parishes around the city with a variety of speakers. We will be producing a poster over the next few weeks and the topics will all be related to the Holy Bible. This might be something to help you through Lent and Advent 2020.

We have parents' meetings this week for children making their First Confession, 6.30pm on Wednesday for Christ the King parents and 4.30pm on Thursday for St Augustine's parents.

As you know we have a very thriving youth ministry in the parish, with a Youth Group and a Youth Café Group. We are looking to recruit some new leaders. You have to be over 18 years. We will give you full training and arrange Safeguarding
