Dear Parishioners

This week we begin our Lenten Journey. Wednesday is Ash Wednesday and we have a choice of four Masses. I know that it is half term and many of you will be away, but if you are around, please try to come to Mass and receive your ashes. We have all the Lenten materials available this weekend. We have the purple sheets outlining the weekly parish programme and the arrangements for Holy Week. We will have regular Stations of the Cross, some extra masses, the Service of Anointing for the Sick and Housebound and our Passover Meal. There will also be opportunities for Confession and a Penance Service with visiting Priests. These are all arranged to help you make the most of Lent. There are also "Walk With Me" Books and Calendars available, free of charge! We also have a weekly Lenten Prayer Group on Tuesday's at 2.00pm in the Meeting Room.

We will be arranging some Deanery Talks for Lent and Advent 2020, which will be hosted by parishes around the city with a variety of speakers. We will be producing a poster over the next few weeks and the topics will all be related to the Holy Bible. This might be something to help you through Lent and Advent 2020.

As you know we have a very thriving youth ministry in the parish, with a Youth Group and a Youth Café Group. We are looking to recruit some new leaders. You have to be over 18 years. We will give you full training and arrange Safeguarding checks. The Youth Groups meet on Tuesday evenings in term time. Why not give it a go!! The training course will be held here at Christ the King and begins on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> March at 7.30pm in the Library.

The Talks on the Faith resume this Thursday at 7.00pm and the subject will be on the "Eucharist and Holy Communion".
