Title

The name of this initiative is Christ The King Youth Group Online and is part of Christ The King Parish Coventry. Is hereafter referred to as the Youth Group and is responsible for youth work in the parish of Christ The King Coventry.

Mission Statement

Aim

Membership

Parents and guardians of young people attending the Youth Group are responsible for overseeing any online activities.

Roles and Responsibilities

The Parish Priest. The Parish Priest of Christ The King is responsible for overseeing the running of the Youth Group including online and the appointment of competent Youth Leaders. This will include: obtaining the necessary CRB clearance and where appropriate provision of appropriate training, prior to the appointment of a Youth Leader.

Youth Leaders. Youth Leaders are responsible for the day-to-day running of the Youth Group online.

Young People. Young people accessing the Youth Group will be expected to demonstrate a reasonable level of self-control and be responsible for their own actions. They will be expected to abide by the Youth Group rules.
