Dear Parishioners

This weekend we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Trinity. It is a good week in which to celebrate the first of our parish Confirmations. The children from Christ the King will receive the Sacrament this coming Saturday at 10.00am and 12 noon. Canon Paul Fitzpatrick will be administering the sacrament. It will mean that our normal Saturday routine of 9.30am mass followed by the Holy Hour and Confessions, will not take place for the next two weeks as we have Confirmations for St Augustine's on 17<sup>th</sup> June. There is the opportunity for Confession after the 6.00pm Saturday evening Mass. Please pray for those being Confirmed along with the sponsors and their families. Our thanks to the staff at school who have helped with the preparation.

We had a good pilgrimage to Lourdes and remembered you all in our prayers and delivered all of the petitions. 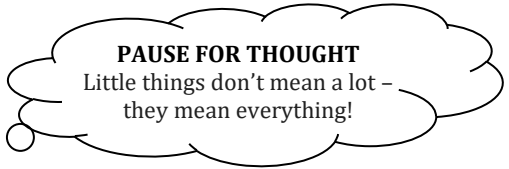
Over the last few weeks students have been sitting SATS tests and I know many are in the middle of other exams and tests. We wish all our students well and pray that they will get the good results of their hard work.
