Dear Parishioners

This weekend we continue our First Holy Communion celebrations with the children from Christ the King School at the 10.00am and 12 noon masses this Saturday. Tomorrow at the 12 noon Mass we will have the Crowning of Our Lady's Statue led by the Communion children. The children at non-Catholic schools will be making their First Holy Communion as well at a 3.00pm Mass. We pray for all of those who have received First Holy Communion over the last couple of weeks.

On Monday 27th May we will be leaving for the Parish trip to Lourdes and we will remember you all in prayer. If you wish to drop in a petition for Lourdes, please post it through the Presbytery door and we will bring the petition for you. Just mark the envelope "Lourdes Petition". There is no need to place any money in the envelope. Deacon Keith and Fr Dominic have been in Medjugorje this last week and return on Sunday. They too have offered prayers for the parish. There are 40 from the parish going to Lourdes, including 20 from the Youth Group, who will be helping in the hospital.

Thanks to all those who have offered to support Fr Dominic's St Mary's Trust Project in India. There are photo displays at the back of each church telling you about the work. If you would like to sponsor a child, the packs are now available from the office. This Sunday morning we will start the breakfast and activity club for primary school children who are neurodivergent, along with any other children who may benefit from this group, even without formal diagnosis. The meeting starts at 11.00am in the Library.
