Dear Parishioners

This weekend we continue our Cemetery Blessings and we will be at St Paul's Cemetery. We will meet at the Chapel for a short prayer service and then move to individual family graves for blessings. The following weeks will be at London Road and then Lenton's Lane. We have begun the Open Meetings for the Deanery with Bishop Richard Walker and this last week we met for the parishes around St Thomas More's and Sacred Heart. This coming week we have the meetings for Nuneaton and we have our own area meeting at 7.00pm on Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> October. This is a very important meeting for the future of the parish and our working closely with neighbouring parishes. Please make every effort to attend, especially if you are involved in any one of the many parish groups and activities. It would be good to have read the Future Planning Leaflet that we distributed a couple of weeks ago as a preparation for the meeting. More copies are available at the back of the church. Our local MP, Taiwo Owatemi will be holding a clinic on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> October from 4.00pm to 6.00pm. You may have matters you want to discuss with her.

Fr Benedict has produced a short training video for our Ministers, especially for those who were not able to attend The Eucharistic Devotion. The video can be found on the parish website homepage and on the parish YouTube channel. If you would like to be considered as a Eucharistic Minister or a Reader, please let me know.

The course on Catholicism has now begun and you may wish to come along to this, even if you missed the first session. The next Young Adults Group will meet on Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> October at 7.00pm at St Osburg's Church Hall. Please note the change of venue.

The Mass Diary books will be available for children making their First Confession, First Holy Communion and Confirmation this year. We will start using them on 27<sup>th</sup> October in time for the first Parents Meetings in November.

Dates for the Sacraments are First Holy Communion, St Augustine's on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> May and for Christ the King on Saturday, 17<sup>th</sup> May 2025. First Confessions will be on Wednesday, 19<sup>th</sup> March for Christ the King at 6.00pm and at St Augustine's on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> March at 4.30pm. Confirmations will be Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> June for Christ the King and Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> June for St Augustine's.

As mentioned we now have Saturday evening Confessions at 5.30pm to 5.55pm before the Saturday evening Mass, rather than afterwards. I think this will be more convenient for most people.

We will be training and recruiting new servers over the next few months. Anyone, Year 4 and above is eligible. Fr Benedict has visited the schools to encourage new Altar Servers.

Because of new data regulations, anyone on the Sanctuary who may be seen on the livestream, have to give consent. Could all Readers, Ministers, Sacristans, flower arrangers and cleaners call into the Sacristy to sign the consent form. This is just a formality from the Diocese.

To try and keep the porch as tidy as possible, the donation bins for Global Care, the Foodbank and the Bookbank are now around the corner in the first confession room. Please place all your donations in the usual bins provided. Which are now stored there.

We no longer take spectacles! These can be handed in at Spec Savers. We will be discussing the membership of the new Parish Council over the next few weeks and I will be inviting various people involved in parish groups and activities to be involved.
