Dear Parishioners

This weekend we continue our Cemetery Blessings and we will be at London Road Cemetery. We will meet at the War Memorial in the newer part of the Cemetery, off London Road for a short prayer service and then move to individual family graves for blessings. Next week we will be at Lenton's Lane.

This weekend we will be speaking about the Assisted Suicide Bill, which had its first reading in Parliament on Wednesday and will be debated over the next few weeks before a vote in the House of Commons. We will be reading a letter from Cardinal Vincent Nichols and copies are available at the back of church as well. I would ask you to read this carefully as it sets out some of the concerns raised by this issue. We would also ask you to write to or email your MP to express our concerns. For most of us this will be Taiwo Owatemi. I realise some may be sympathetic to the Bill and we respect peoples views, but I think there is real dangers that we need to carefully consider.

Thanks to all who attended the Open Meetings for the Deanery with Bishop Richard Walker. Hopefully, it will help us to begin thinking about the importance of Pastoral Councils for the parish and for the Deanery and to look at ways of working closely with our neighbouring parishes and to support the work of our schools in promoting our faith. It would be good to read the Future Planning Leaflet that we distributed a couple weeks ago if you have not already done so. More copies are available at the back of the church. We will be discussing the membership of the new Parish Council over the next few weeks and I will be inviting various people involved in parish groups and activities to be involved.

Our local MP, Taiwo Owatemi will be holding a clinic on Friday 18th October from 3.45pm to 6.00pm. You may have matters you want to discuss with her.

The course on Catholicism has now begun and you may wish to come along to this, even if you missed the first session. See the leaflet at the back of the church for the dates of the meetings. The next Young Adults Group will meet on Tuesday $29^{\rm th}$ October at 7.00pm at St Osburg's Church Hall. Please note the change of venue.


