This week we continue our journey through Lent. This week we also celebrate St Patrick's Day on Monday and there will be the usual morning Mass at 9.30am. I know there will be celebrations over the weekend and there is a Coffee Morning straight after morning Mass in the Library to support the PTA. Please do try to come along. This week the children from Christ the King (Wednesday at 6.00pm) and St Augustine's (Thursday at 4.30pm), will be making their First Confessions and we will have some visiting priests available to hear the parents Confessions as well. The children at non-Catholic schools will make their Confessions on Tuesday 25th March. Please pray for these children.

I would encourage you to look at something on our Lenten Programme and choosing something to strengthen your spiritual life, as well as the traditional practice of giving something up and helping those in need. All three aspects of Lent are important, our Prayer, our Fasting and our Almsgiving. Our Wednesday 7.00am Mass maybe something you may wish to consider. We are hoping to make this our Parish Charity for this Jubilee Year and help them to build a school hall over the next couple of years. We will be sending a donation from the parish funds to start the project and then we will look at some fund raising opportunities during the year and perhaps have a special collection for them.

Looking at the pilgrimage options, we will arrange the Lourdes Pilgrimage with the Diocese from Saturday  $24^{\rm th}$  May to Friday  $30^{\rm th}$  May, 6 nights at a cost of £900 per person sharing and £1,050 for single. This is a rate for Christ the King parishioners only. Could you now start to make a definite booking in the office if you wish to go. Of the other pilgrimages, Rome seems the most popular. We have arranged to travel from Thursday,  $13^{\rm th}$  to Monday  $17^{\rm th}$  November, 4 nights half board for £900 per person sharing and £1,100 single. There are only 30 places available, so please book early. Again, to book a definite place please call the office.
