Dear Parishioners

This week the children at non-Catholic schools will make their First Confessions this Tuesday evening. Congratulations to those at Christ the King and St Augustine's who made their First Confessions last Wednesday and Thursday. Over the next couple of weeks, we will be hearing Confessions in our schools and all of this is a reminder to all adults that we too need to receive the Sacrament as part of our Easter duties. We need to acknowledge that, it's not just the children in school who need the Sacrament. We have our Lenten Penance Service on Tuesday 15th April at 7.00pm and I would encourage you to make a commitment to come along to this. There will be guideline sheets to help you with the Sacrament of Confession.

Next weekend, we will be having a Cake Sale at the Masses to help raise funds for our young people going to Lourdes. We do need people to confirm their place on the Lourdes Pilgrimage with the Diocese. The dates are Saturday 24^{th} May to Friday 30^{th} May, 6 nights at a cost of £900 per person sharing and £1,050 for single. This is a rate for Christ the King parishioners only. We need to know by the end of March if you are intending to go. You can secure a place with a deposit of £100. We have also arranged a pilgrimage to Rome from Thursday, 13^{th} to Monday 17^{th} November, 4 nights half board for £900 per person sharing and £1,100 single. There are only 30 places available, so please book early. Again, to book a definite place please call the office. You will need a deposit of £100 to secure your place.

Thanks to those who helped organise the various events for St Patrick's weekend. I would encourage you to look at something on our Lenten Programme and choosing something to strengthen your spiritual life, as well as the traditional practice of giving something up and helping those in need.
